- Sunday, April 30. Students in Grade 6-8 will be leading worship during this service. The whole school will be performing a song. We hope that everyone can make it to this service.

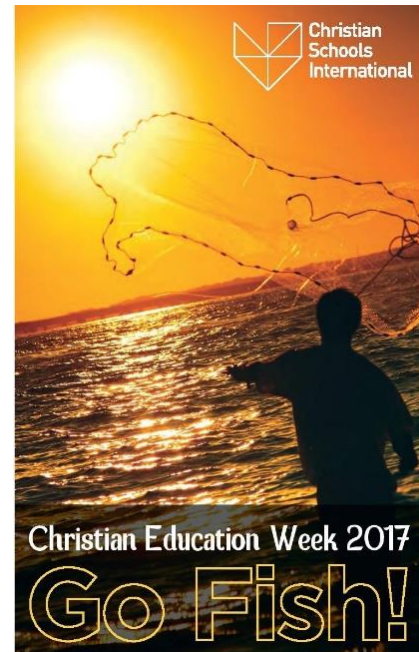
Evening Performance - Thursday, May 4 beginning at 7pm.
