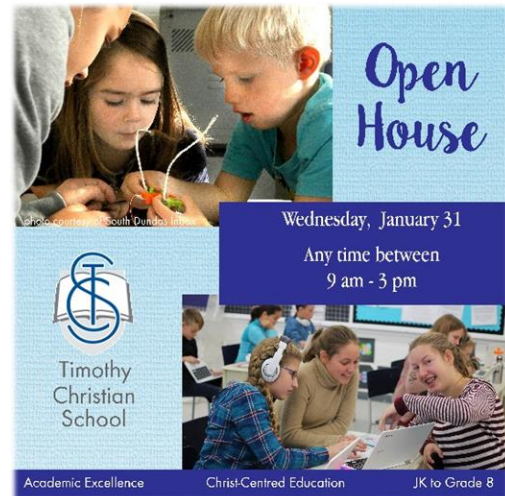
Kindergarten Chapel has been moved to **Friday, February 2**. Chapel will begin at 8:45 and everyone is welcome.
