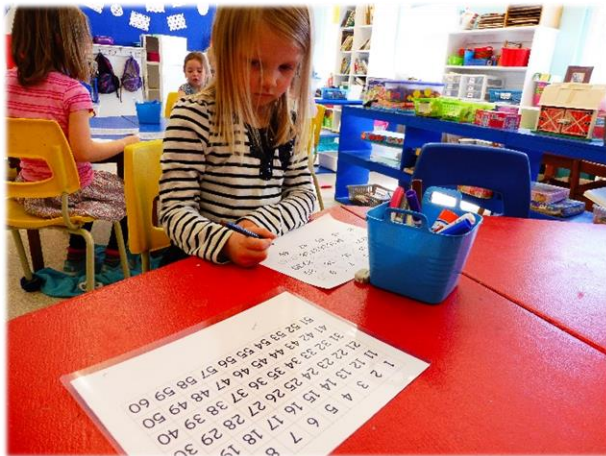

Our **April PD** day has been rescheduled to Friday, April 20. Please mark it on your calendars.


