Grade 3/4

Spelling: Lesson 6. Spelling test Friday. This is a review unit on the previous 5 units, so I picked a few tricky words from Lesson 1-5 and compiled a Lesson 6 Spelling List. It's a second chance to practice words we had trouble with over the past 5 weeks!
