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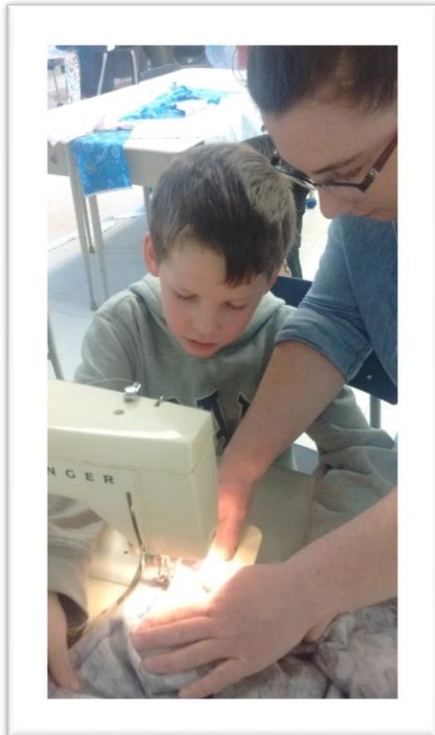

From the Classrooms:

Grade 8

Math: Students have a take home test on the Pythagorean theorem that is due on Wednesday. We are starting our new unit on Ratios & Circles. As we begin this, we are going to be making pizzas on Wednesday, working with ratios for the recipe, and looking at circumference and area of pizzas. There will be a separate email about what we need for this.

Science: Students will have a quiz about types of forces on Wednesday.

Bible: We are beginning review of Advent.

Grade 3/4

Memory Work: Titus - 2 Peter for Friday.

Math: We will have a Math test on Tuesday on Geometry. Students should be familiar with the properties of specific shapes (parallel lines, right angles, equilateral shapes). We will do an in-class review on Monday. I will also send home a review sheet on Monday.

Spelling: (Test on Friday) Students will be tested on their Lesson 17 words on Friday. Both Grades are concentrating on the "long u" sound.

Memory Work: None this week.

Bible Test: (Test on Thursday) Last week we finished our unit on Jesus' Miracles. We will be reviewing his miracles in class on Tuesday and Wednesday. Duotangs will also go home each night to help students review and study for their test.
