From the Classrooms:

Grade 8

Math: World's Largest Coffee project due on Wednesday. Test on Circle unit will be on Friday.

Science: We continue to work on our unit on Forces and Work.

French: Students must complete their assignment "La Musique dans ma vie" due Friday. They will be presented in class on Friday as well.

Spelling: Lesson 17 due Tuesday. Quiz Tuesday.

Writing Assignment: 1000 word paper due Tuesday, Feb 26. We will work on it in class next week.

Grade 5/6

Math: We are working on 2-D Geometry - lines, angles, properties of polygons. We will be finishing up the work for this unit this week and will have a test on in next week Wednesday.

French: M. Andre Charlebois will be doing oral evaluations on Friday this week. Grade 5 will begin writing Miniproject 1, for our unit Mon Alimentation, describing their eating habits. See agenda for due date.

Grade 6 is working on their final draft of Miniproject 2, for our unit La Musique, sharing their favourite singer or group. Good copies due Thursday.

Spelling: Lesson 15 list work is due this Wednesday and our test will be on Thursday.

Grade 3/4

Welcome back after the Family Day weekend! I hope that everyone had a fantastic weekend enjoying time with their families.

Social Studies: We continue to have fun learning about the country of China. Last week, we highlighted some of the major religions in China, and this week we will focus on the Christian church in China. We hope to have Mrs. Daye talk to our class about her experiences teaching in nearby Hong Kong!

Math: Grade 3s continue to explore and learn about multiplication. Grade 4s are starting a new unit on Patterns.

Spelling: Lesson 20 Test on Friday. Grade 3s are focussing on vowel sounds paired with r (ir, or, ar, er, ur). Grade 4s are looking at vowel digraphs ei and ie.

Memory Work: We are almost finished looking at the books of the New Testament. Students should know Matthew - 2 Thessalonians for Friday.

Bible: We are continuing to learn about Elijah and Elisha. We are enjoying learning about how God continuously showed His love and providence to the Israelites.

Grammar: We are finishing up our Unit on Adjectives. We will have a couple of review periods in the classroom and will have a test on Friday.

French: Students are learning how to read our play with correct oral pronunciation. We will be practicing together this week and students may bring home their notebooks to practice. Please ensure these are returned to school each day. An oral French reading test will occur next week.

Grade 1/2

Spelling: (Test on Friday) Students will be tested on their Lesson 20 words on Friday. Grade One is studying the "ea" sound, and Grade Two is concentrating on the "oi" sound.

Memory Work: (for Friday) none this week.

French: Students will be given a role in our French play to practice. We have 5 characters so students will divide up the parts for each character. More info to follow with their individual role. These will be sent home on Thursday.
