Grade 8

Tuesday March 5: Don't forget to bring in your trip form for tomorrow.

Math: We are working on integer operations. There will be a test on Friday.

New Science Unit: We have started a science unit about Flight. Currently we are learning about the principles of air that God has put in place. We will have a small **Quiz Thursday** on the principles of air.

Grade 3/4

Social Studies: We are coming to the end of our China unit. It has been a blast learning about an entirely different culture! We will be wrapping things up in class this week and will have a test on Friday.

Bible: We have been having fun learning about Elijah and the Israelites during the time of King Ahab. We are finishing up our unit and will have a test on Elijah on Wednesday.

Spelling: Lesson 22 test on Friday.

Grammar: We will be reviewing nouns, verbs and adjectives all together and practicing identifying them in sentences. We will have a quiz on Thursday.

Memory Work: We are excited to be learning our theme passage, Psalm 8, over the next few weeks. This week we will be learning Psalm 8:1. Students will be tested on Friday. Students are expected to learn Psalm 8:2 by themselves **during March Break** and will be tested the following Monday.

Grade 1/2

Spelling (Test on Friday): Students will be tested on their Lesson 21 words. Grade One is studying the “igh” sounds and Grade Two is concentrating on the “ou” sound.
