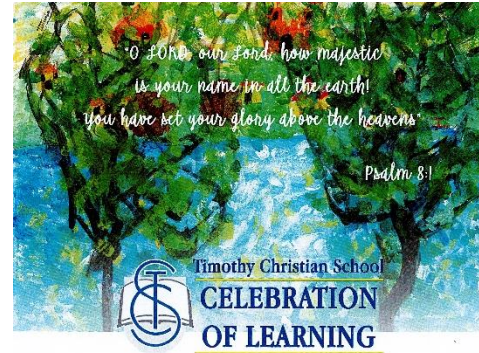
Spring Celebration of Learning is coming very soon! Invitations are available at the office. Some things to remember in anticipation:

Grade 8

Math: We begin a new unit on angles and angle theorems this week.

Spelling: Lesson 28 Test on Friday. Grade 3s are learning about silent 'l' and 'gh' sounds, while the Grade 4s are learning about using apostrophes to show possession or to contract two words.

Math: Grade 3s will have a quiz on Time on Friday. Students should know how to read a digital and analog clock, as well as use terms such as "half past", "quarter to/past".

Memory Work (for Friday): "All flocks and herds, and the beasts of the field, the birds of the air and the fish of the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas." Psalm 8:7-8.

Spelling (Test on Friday): Students will be tested on their Lesson 27 words. Grade 1 is studying the "oi" sound and Grade 2 is concentrating on the "are" sound.
