From the Classrooms:

Grade 8

Quebec Trip: Forms will be going home and need to be returned to the school. Our itinerary and other info will be passed along later this week. Cost does not include having a fundraiser yet. When we do our fundraiser then students will receive money back.

Math: We are working on surface area, then moving on to reviewing before our exam in June.

French: Students will be receiving homework while we are working on grammar.

Bible: We are reading “The Case for Faith – Student Edition” Objection 2.

Science: Test on Friday on forces, energy and energy sources.

History: Charlemagne questions due Thursday in class.

Language Arts: Finish chapter 6 in ‘I am David’ and answer the comprehension questions. Also add 1 more box to the character web on David – due Thursday. Complete the friendly letter writing for Thursday if not already done. Begin thinking of a topic for your 5-paragraph essay on your novel. Work on Grad Presentations.

Grad Presentations: Dates are chosen and students will be working on invitations this week. They need to continue to work on writing and editing their presentation, with suggestions from their mentor teacher.

Grade 5/6

Garbage Project goes to Art on the Waterfront: We have an amazing opportunity to participate in Art on the Waterfront in Chesterville on Saturday, June 1st. The event runs from 10am-4pm. I will be there and if there are some students that can join me that would be amazing. Let me know if and when your child can help out. No worries if they can't.
