Grade 8

Language Arts: Grammar – Test on nouns Tuesday

Write Traits – Edit Voice paragraphs

Literature – Finish reading chapter 4 of I am David

Math: Quiz on angles and triangles on Friday.

Grade 3/4

Spelling: Lesson 29 Unit due and test on Friday. Grade 3s are learning about the different ways to make the “au” sound – using “au”, “aw”, “al”, “o”, and “ou”. Grade 4s are looking at spelling the plural possessive form of words using -s'!
