Grade 8

Grade 5/6

French Grade 5: Oral presentations Wednesday.

Math: We are working on coordinate grids.

Grade 3/4

We have our end of the year class trip planned for **Thursday, June 20th**. We will be going to Mont Cascades waterpark. Math: Grade 4s have finished their unit on Data and Probability. Students will have a test on Wednesday including mean, median and range and probability (even, likely, unlikely, certain and impossible outcomes). Spelling: Both grades will have a spelling test on Lesson 34 on Friday.
