Grade 7

French: Students are working on a small mini project on a tourist location in Canada. Due next week Wednesday. ML

Grade 5/6

Spelling: We will have a spelling test on Lesson 2 on Friday, September 20. The students all have a list and a list was also shared with them on their school gmail account. HB

Ancient Egypt: We are studying Ancient Egypt and asking the question, "How did the land shape the community?" We have done some research on the Egyptian Gods and are reading a book together called *Tales of Ancient Egypt*. This week we will start to look at the Pharaohs and how they led Ancient Egypt to become a great civilization. HB
