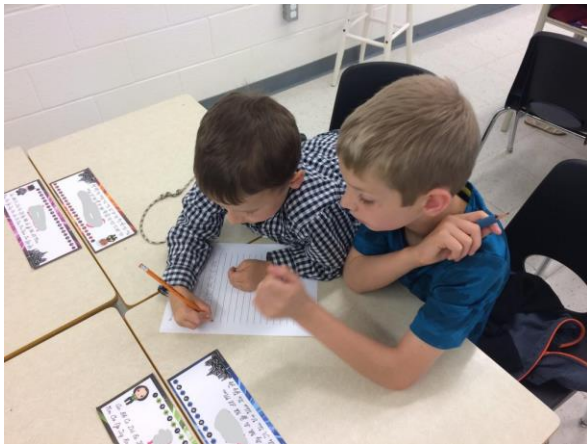

From the Classrooms:

Grade 7

French: Students are working on a small mini project on a tourist location in Canada. Due Wednesday. ML

Grade 5/6

Ancient Egypt: We continue studying Ancient Egypt, asking the question, "How did the land shape the community?" We have been learning about the Pharaohs and how the ancient Egyptians actually believed he or she was a god, thus they listened to everything they said. We are also enjoying reading *The Tales of Ancient Egypt* and wondering about how some of their myths connect to the Biblical story. HB
