## From the Classrooms:

### Grade 7

**French:** Students have oral reading testing this week. We will be practicing in class. ML

**Bible:** Test on Colossians Friday, ML

**Memory Work:** none this week ML

**History:** Ancient Rome project is due this **Thursday, November 6th**. Continue to work on preparing your handout for this project as well as preparing your artifacts or posters for your presentation. ADK

**Spelling:** Unit 8 lesson: Thursday, Test: Friday Students are encouraged to practice. Unit 7 returned today. ML

## Grade 5/6

**Spelling:** We will have a spelling test on Lesson 8 on Friday. The students all have a list and a list was also shared with them on their school g-mail account. We have started to use a program called [Spelling City](#) to do some of our spelling work. The students all have an account and they are given assignments each week. They can also use the program at home to practice their spelling words. HB

**French 6:** Students have oral reading testing this week. We will be practicing in class. ML

**Bible:** Test on Colossians Friday. ML

**Memory Work:** none this week ML

**Math:** We are learning multiplication of larger numbers. We are also working on our times tables, with daily speed drills. Students should have written in their agenda the set of multiplication facts that they are working on. KG

**Music:** Students should be taking home their ukulele to practice 1-2 times a week. They should practice switching between chords and strumming evenly. KG

## Grade 3/4

**Memory Work:** "The Lord does not look at the things man looks at. Man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart." 1 Samuel 16:7b due on Friday. This will be an oral Memory Work. A reminder that students should be practicing their Memory Work at home as well as here at school.

**Spelling:** Lesson 9 Test and Unit due on Friday. Grade 3s are learning about words with consonant blends (s blends, r blends, and l blends); Grade 4s are learning about consonant digraphs (two consonants together that make one new sound). Spelling lists are attached in each student's agenda so that they can practice their spelling words at home.

**Math:** Grade 3s will be finishing up their Addition and Subtraction Unit this week. They will have a test on Thursday on parts and totals, mental math and some word problems using addition or subtraction. Grade 4s are finishing up their short unit on Geometry this week. Students will have a test next Monday on shapes.

**Science:** We are finished looking at our unit on Trees. We will be starting a new unit on Mammals and are excited to learn about some of the amazing creatures God has created!
