## **From the Office:**



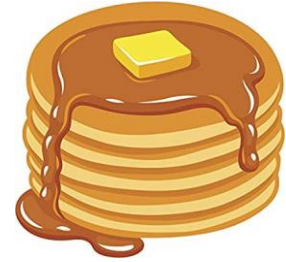

### Grade 7

**Article of the Week (AoW):** We Read Canadian due: Thursday ML

**Grammar:** see agenda for assignments. ML

**Math:** We are working on a unit in measurement. KG

**Science:** Unit test on "The Wonder of Cells" next this Wednesday.

## Grade 5/6

**Agenda:** Most students are using their agendas faithfully. Please make sure to check in for weekly assignments and activities.

**French 5/6:** Grade 5 students are writing a recipe in French. Students need to record themselves making and explaining their recipe. Grade 6 students are writing a paragraph about their favourite singer.
