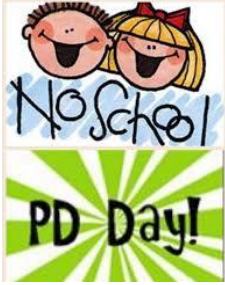
Peek of the Week: We had a lot of fun being wacky and tacky on Friday!

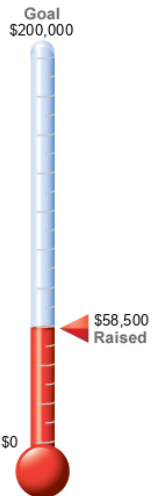

From the Classrooms:

Grade 7/8

Spelling: Test on Wednesday, March 17.

Writing: This week we will work on an essay about best/worst inventions.

Literature: Refugee backpack assignment due Tuesday, March 16

Memory Work: Proverbs 3:1-12

Bible: We are wrapping up our Proverbs unit with drama presentations and we will have a test on Thursday, March 17. Part of the test will include a review of the memory work from Proverbs 3.

Reading Logs: Students are expected to read for 20 minutes at home daily (at least four nights a week) and to keep track of their reading using a reading log which is checked on Thursdays.
